Wording for your Will

There are a variety of gifts you can nominate in your Will.

A residuary gift is a percentage of the remainder of your estate after debts have been paid and all pecuniary and specific gifts have been distributed. Residuary gifts provide Guide Dogs Queensland with the greatest impact.

A pecuniary gift is a fixed sum of money left to Guide Dogs Queensland. You can also leave a specific gift such as an asset or shares.

Whatever you decide, to ensure your wishes are met, please include the following wording in your Will:

"I bequeath [____ percent of my residual Estate / the sum of \$____/ specific item(s) _____] to Guide Dogs Queensland Limited (ABN 89 009 739 664) free of all duties and I declare that the receipt of the Chief Executive Officer of said Organisation shall be a complete discharge to my Executors and Trustees for the moneys paid in accordance with this bequest."
